Highlight Report

In the last month, the overall situation of Iran has been effected by general changes in the aftermath of presidential election and its related tensions and discrepancies and on Student Day (December 6) universities again faced protests and on the hand, official authorities conflicted with people and detained some of the protesters. In this situation, in which different ignitions appeared in the performance of political and social activists or reactions of official centers, one universal occasion which is also within the mandate of the IHRC (International Human Rights Day) affected most actions in this month. The 2009 Universal theme was "Embrace Diversity, End Discrimination" and for making this theme understandable at the national level, the theme of "Responsibilities of Islamic States for Expanding Diversity and Pluralism of Thoughts and Eliminating Discrimination" was chosen by the Commission, and on this basis, IHRC organized different activities in Tehran and other provinces. The observable point in this matter was that due to public situation of the country or inattention of most institutes and organizations to universal occasions, no other institute or organization, even among civil society organizations, had any program for respecting human rights on the occasion of International Human Rights Day and only one NGO facing various limitations from officials, publicized its initiative of granting its Human Rights Award to one of the prominent socio-political critics during a visit held on International Human Rights Day in honor of him. Anyway, as is the usual trend with IHRC, in the framework of its purposeful and major attempts and in spite of different challenges related to country's situation, considered International

Human Rights Day is communicative enough in this matter and shows serious concerns of this organization for promotion of human rights along with other nations. In present Newsletter, samples of different activities including holding gatherings and providing research, promotional and ... products are introduced that all done on the occasion of International Human Rights Day. It should be mentioned that despite of the existing disappointing atmosphere and despair and tension in society which normally prevent from carrying out influential and expert planned activities, all said activities were carried out and all of them are the result of nonstop attempts of IHRC staff in Tehran and other provinces. It is interesting that these are done with minimum facilities and mostly by efforts, strong will and cooperation of all related activists. It is hoped that all of these attempts will be a step, even a small one, toward promoting respect for human rights.

Human Rights Monitoring

According to the routine practice of the IHRC, during past four weeks, national and international monitoring units continually recorded hundreds of news and reports on human rights issues. Those who are interested can buy CD of domestic human rights monitoring reports on the 16 human rights priorities from the IHRC related unit or they can study collection of reports and published claims about human rights observance or violation in Iran which were considered by IHRC domestic monitoring unit and published regularly on the website. During last month, in international monitoring unit, there were also five separate monthly reports on human rights situation in five sections of the world (Europe-America, Latin America, Asia-Pacific, Africa, Islamic Arabic countries) with denotation on situation of each region. Those who are interested can purchase it from IHRC bookshop. In this period, some considered news in IHRC domestic monitoring unit were referred to Commission's Legal Affairs to be pursued by filing complaint like written complaints from people. Many of the received news and reports were related to arrested people in post election events and their relevant issues. Unfortunately, IHRC or other pacifiers and reformers of country, because of tense atmosphere of the country, could not do any significant reform in official's approaches and practices for strengthening accountability, rule of law and respect for citizenship's rights. Apart from public contacts with

Human Rights Day as other national and universal occasions in which it can be talked about human rights as far as possible, and by explaining its theoretical aspects and providing practical products, draw the attention of different governmental and non-governmental audiences to necessity of attempts for promoting human rights. IHRC, as its usual approach to all important occasions, also tried to represent cultural, national and Islamic aspects of the subject, in order to recognize our native background or to avoid acting like those people who always try to separate national culture and Islamic ideology from world accepted values. IHRC statement on the occasion of Universal Hu-



calling system of IHRC Tele-Clinic for providing legal assistance in Tehran and other provinces, IHRC received 62 written complaints directly sent by citizens. Some of them are as follows:

- Complaint of Shahnaz Shiroud Rezaee and her request for finding her 17 year old son, Ashkan Rezaee who was disappeared 4.5 months ago.
- Complaint of Mohammad Ali Vazirabadi from Tabriz who had complained about judicial proceedings of his case.
- Hassani's letter, an Afghan citizen, who is resident of Iran and his willingness for following up problems of Afghan immigrants in Iran.
- Complaint of Hamid Zeinolabedin from Qom and his request of legal assistance for car accident case.
- Complaint of Malagha Soltani about her family difficulties and her request of legal and advisory assistance for realization of her rights from her runaway husband.

- Complaint of Majid Sadrie about his livelihood problems and his request for solving them.
- Complaint of Mohammad Reza Javadi about violation of his occupational rights in Lorestan Education Administration.
- Complaint of Mohammad Reza Yousefi Ashmanloo from Tabriz prison and request for legal assistance in his judicial case.
- Complaints of some Tonkabonian citizens belonged to non-officially-recognized minorities about searching their homes and ... by police and security officers and their request for respecting their citizenship's rights.
- Letter of Karim Teimoori Naghdeh who has complained about ill-treatment of Nakhjavan's officials and his request for providing more protection to Iranians there.
- Received report from Shiraz about educational problems of Afghan Students in this city and the request for continuing their education.
- Complaint of Masoumeh Saber Nejad from Tehran and her request for officials' help in order to become able to earn her life decently as a family supervisor.

Events

In recent month, different mass programs held by IHRC in Tehran and other provinces independently or in coordination with other institutes. Here are their titles and a brief explanation about each of them:

- [Meetings on Surveying Theosophy and Human Rights Dimensions \(Qom, Nov.19 & 26 & Dec.10\):](#)

Following previous meetings held in Regional Office No. 5 in Qom city on above-mentioned dates, three other meetings held with presence of related experts in which the discussion about this subject was finished and in future another subject will be disputed in IHRC Qom Series Meetings. Also, the collection of discussed items in different research meetings on theosophy and human rights will be prepared in written reports shortly in order to be used by interested researchers. According to the discussed items, it is also supposed that several researches on this subject will be done by IHRC.



- Meeting on “New Methods of Stable and Easy Marriage” (Tabriz, Nov.22):

The mentioned meeting held by Office No.7 with coordination of Department of Family and Women Affairs in Eastern Azerbaijan and by the help of Research Department of IHRC in Tehran. One of the professors in the field of Women’s Rights from Tehran attended this gathering. Several lecturers offered speeches from legal, judicial and religious points of view and also media broadcasted the news of this gathering.



- Technical Meeting on “Reviewing Yemen Crisis from International Humanitarian Law viewpoint” (Central Office, Nov.22):

Following the distressing incidents in Yemen in which a great number of civilians were killed or injured, Research Department of IHRC, in one of its periodical scientific meetings in Nov.22, investigated the crisis in Yemen with presence of a group of International law professors and experts. ISNA reflected the summery of the discussed subjects. The full report of the discussion also prepared and is available at the IHRC bookshop for public use.



- Special Meeting on the occasion of International Human Rights Day (Kermanshah – Dec.10):

Within the framework of IHRC programs and on the occasion of International Human Rights Day, following the arrangement of Regional Office No.1 in Kermanshah province, a special meeting was held in the Assembly Room of Kermanshah Azad University with presence of legal scholars and other experts in the province. The IHRC Central Office delegated a university legal professor and a researcher of Islamic thought to speak in the meeting.



- Special Meeting on “Respecting Diversity and Pluralism of Thoughts within National and International Arena” on the occasion of International Human Rights Day (Tabriz – Dec.10):

Following the arrangements of Regional Office No. 7 in Tabriz province, this meeting was held within the framework of IHRC programs on the occasion of International Human Rights Day in, and with cooperation of, Assembly Room of Tabriz Bar Association. In this meeting, our delegated professor along with some of the judiciary and legal officials of Tabriz and university centers delivered lectures and at the end, the province’s active journalists in the area of human rights were appreciated.



- Special Meeting on the occasion of International Human Rights Day (Shiraz – Dec.9):

This meeting was held by Regional Office No. 1 and by pursuing of the Research Department of Central Office. The dispatched deputy of UN Information Unit from Tehran together with one of the professors of international law had presentations. The UN General Secretary’s statement and the IHRC statement on the International Human Rights Day were also distributed and read in this meeting.



- Special Meeting on “Human Rights and Its Islamic and Persian Background” on the occasion of International Human Rights Day (Tehran, Dec.13):

The Central Office’s program on the occasion of International Human Rights Day did not hold at the venue of Commission so that the capacity was not enough for possible interlocutors and participants. Thus, based on previous preparation and with the coordination of Law Faculty of Shahid Beheshti University, this meeting was held at Justice Hall of the Faculty with presence of great number of lawyers, students, officials, representatives of religious minorities and media. Three prominent legal professors gave speeches in this gathering and their discussions were welcomed by the audience due to their sensitivity. There were also two other important events in this program: unveiling the new published book by the Commission which includes the essays of scholars about the sixtieth anniversary of Universal Declaration of Human Rights and unveiling of the stamp about the Universal Anniversary of Human Rights which was prepared by IHRC innovation for the first time during the past 30 years in Iran.





- Seminar on “Surveying Social Vulnerabilities of Women and Family” (Hamedan, Dec.12-13):

The mentioned gathering was held by Regional Office No. 7 and in collaboration with Administration of Family and Women Affairs in Hamedan and the speakers each outlined one aspect of the gathering’s general theme. A scholar from Tehran was to dispatch to Hamedan but because of the coldness of weather, his flight was cancelled and the text of his speech was distributed in written form.



- Gathering about Young Girls (Ardebil – Dec.17):

Regional Office No. 7 in collaboration with Ardebil Department of Education and Women Affairs of Ardebil Gubernatorial held this gathering in Kosar Hall of Ardebil and each of the dispatched speakers from Eastern Azarbaijan outlined some aspects of the proposed theme. The discussed items were published on the website of Office No. 7 which was reflected on other public media as well.



- Meeting on Human Mentality and Crimes and Punishments and Human Rights Aspects (Damghan , Dec.17&18):

The mentioned gathering was held by Payame Noor University in Damghan province but several months ago, Office No. 6 was also become one of the administrators of the gathering so the Research Department of Central Office submitted a scientific paper for this gathering. The Central Office also dispatched one of its scholars to give a speech in the gathering. The delivered articles to the gathering are to be published by Payame Noor University as a book.

- Meeting on “Surveying the Requirements of Providing a Universal Theory of Islam and Human Rights” (Qom – Dec.17):



The Research Department of IHRC Central Office tried a lot for holding this scientific gathering on the occasion of Universal Human Rights Day in cooperation with Islamic Sciences and Culture Academy which is one of the prominent research centers in Qom. The process of setting up for holding this gathering is as follows: first, one of the experts in Islamic Rights was asked to express his idea about the theme of this event and submitted it in written form which was done and delivered orally in a meeting with presence of scholars and experts of Islamic sciences. Then, some of the distinguished legal experts which were dispatched from Tehran evaluated the proposed idea; other attendants also presented their ideas and criticisms. At the end, the expert who offered the idea gave his explanations and due to the importance of the subject and its diverse theoretical aspects, a second meeting is to be held during next weeks. Following the mentioned gathering, the Commission had compiled various articles and books on the universalism of human rights and gave them to the mentioned expert so that he can use them for future meeting. The written idea is to be distributed among at least 20 experts before the next meeting and they should submit their observations in written form. These observations are given to the mentioned expert so that he can state his final idea in the next meeting.



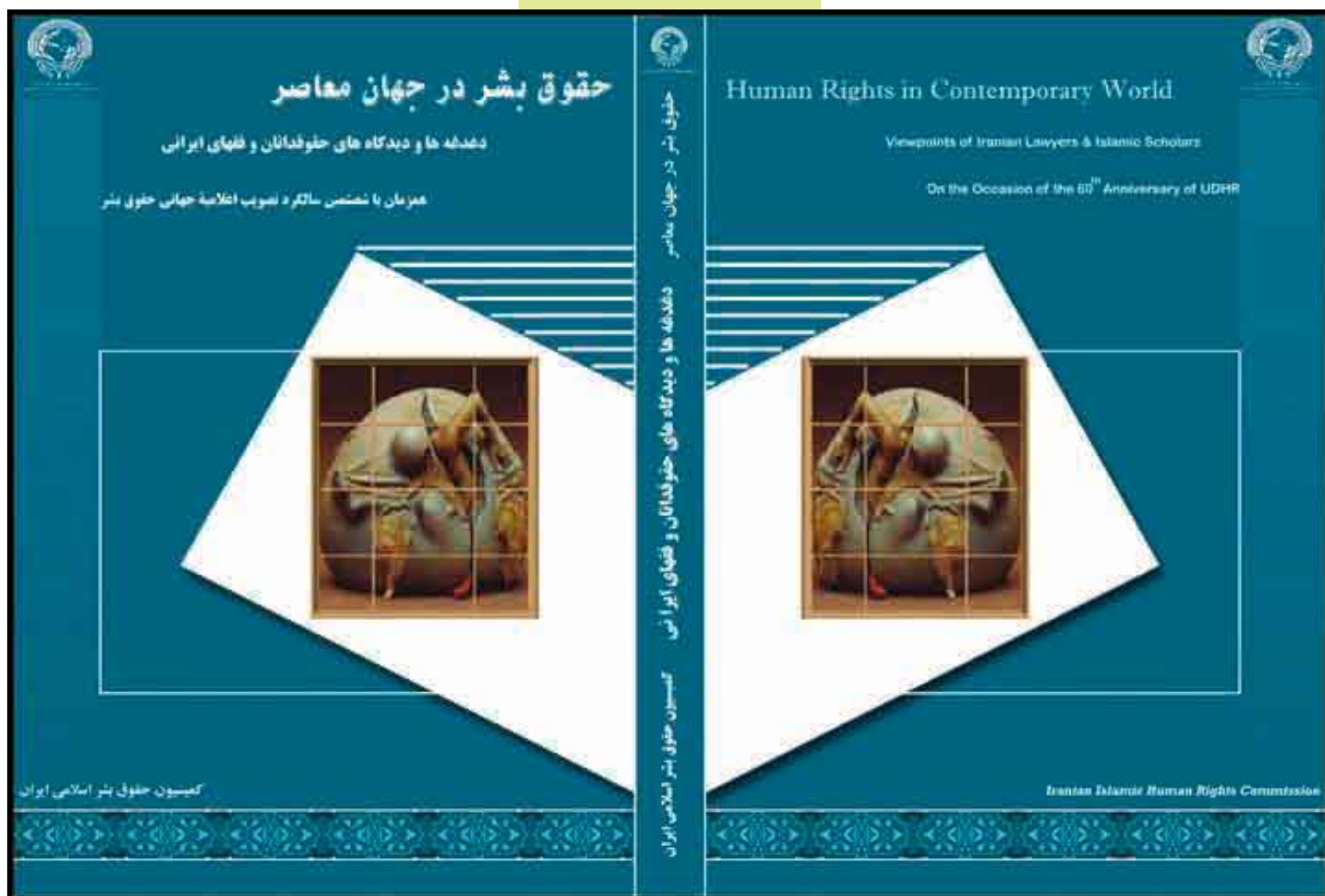
Research

During recent weeks, as it is routine practice of IHRC, there were many theoretical activities some of which were completed and some others are still underway. These include:

1. Compiling of an article titled "Surveying the Effect of Addiction on Mens Rea of Crime and Criminal Responsibility" by one of our colleague in Human Rights and Criminal Justice Process Working Group at Central Office for delivering in Damghan Gathering in Dec.17.
2. Compiling of an article titled "The History of Universal Declaration of Human Rights" for publishing in 2009 book on Universal Human Rights Day which is to be published soon with the title of Ten Papers on Universal Declaration of Human Rights.
3. Compiling of an article titled "Identifying Different Views on Universal Human Rights Declaration Raised by Some Cultures and Nations" for publishing in 2009 book on Universal Human Rights Day.
4. Compiling of an article titled "The Legal Nature of Universal Human Rights Declaration" for publishing in 2009 book on Universal Human Rights Day.
5. Compiling of an article titled "Prohibition of Discrimination in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and Its Reflection on the Process of Standard Setting in the United Nation System" for publishing in 2009 book on Universal Human Rights Day.
6. Compiling of an article titled "Crystallizing the Provisions of Universal Human Rights Declaration in the Countries' Constitutions" for publishing in 2009 book on Universal Human Rights Day.
7. Compiling of an Article titled "A Look at the Reflection of Universal Human Rights Declaration in the Important Regional Instruments" for publishing in 2009 book on Universal Human Rights Day.
8. Compiling of an article titled "Internal and International Good Order and System from Universal Human Rights Declaration Viewpoint" for publishing in 2009 book on Universal Human Rights Day.
9. Compiling of an article titled "Supporting the Vulnerable Groups in the Context of Universal Declaration of Human Rights" for publishing in 2009 book on Universal Human Rights Day.
10. Compiling of an article titled "Limitations of Rights and Freedoms in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights" for publishing in 2009 book on Universal Human Rights Day.
11. Compiling of a report titled "Bibliography of the Books about the Universal Declaration of Human Rights in English and Persian".
12. Compiling of a special statement on the occasion of Universal Human Rights Day to be used in Tehran and other Provinces and also English into Persian translation of the statement of UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, UNESCO General-Director and Islamic Conference Secretary-General on the occasion of Universal Human Rights Day. It should be mentioned that the statement of UN Secretary-General was translated by the UNIF Tehran Office and this translation was distributed during IHRC various events.
13. Compiling of a report titled Five Statements about the Universal Human Rights Day and Tens of Thinkable Points. In this report, the statements of UN Secretary-General, Human Rights High Commissioner, UNESCO General Director, OIL Secretary General and IHRC's were reviewed and their important points were extracted and compared with each other. The mentioned report published on IHRC website.
14. Compiling of two scientific texts by two national experts in minorities' rights and its publication on IHRC website on the occasion of Universal Day of the People with Disability.
15. Final compiling of the scientific report about investigation of right to environment in Iran which includes surveying the legal system, confronting challenges, the role of civic organizations and several interviews by related professors.
16. Compiling of a report titled "Surveying the Activities of NGOs Active in the Area of Women's and Children's Rights" with the aim of further familiarization with NGOs' techniques and methods of action.
17. Completing the new issue of bulletin on "Humanitarian Law, Theoretical Evolution in International Arena" by relating research affairs of the IHRC to be published soon.
18. Receiving various scientific articles by some of the experts and providing necessary materials for Iranian Human Rights Journal, No.1. This Quarterly is available to all on the Universal Human Rights Day through its website. It should be mentioned that this is the first Iranian Human Rights Journal in Iran which is compiled by the IHRC and, in order to be available for more people, it is published on line and not in written form. This quarterly includes "theories, articles, scientific gatherings, events and analysis, introduction of new documents, introduction of books and their comments, reviewing judicial procedures and technical analysis, introduction of techniques and new experiences of NGOs and defendants of human rights" and in each section various scientific materials are provided. Although most part of this quarterly is in Persian, but Arabic, English and French articles will be also accepted and published without any alteration in the next issues. The Journal is available on www.ijhr.ir.



19. Completing researched-based report on criminal justice in relation to children and adolescents from the point of view international human rights principles which is to be published as a special report in news bulletin on the Rights of Women and Children.
20. Compiling of a new periodical report on the judgments and reports of international bodies about the situation of human rights in Iran.
21. During the last month, IHRC Research Committee, in two separate meetings with presence of distinguished legal experts, also investigated the following issues: evaluating the proposed drafts in parliament titled "Monitoring the Behaviors and Performances of Judges" from the viewpoint of human rights principles and evaluating the recent resolution of UN General Assembly about the situation of human rights in Iran and reviewing the IHRC special programs for Universal Human Rights Day. It is notable that some theoretical works were begun in this month which will be finished during next weeks. These include: surveying human rights in thought and manners of Islamic leaders or surveying the application of biotechnology in food production and aspects of intellectual property.
22. Special events of this month in research area was the unveiling of IHRC new published book for sixtieth Anniversary of Universal Human Rights Day titled "Human Rights in Contemporary World, Concerns and Viewpoints of Iranian Islamic Scholars and Lawyers on Sixtieth Anniversary of Universal Day of Human Rights". The book includes the articles of almost thirty Islamic scholars and legal experts in Iran, some of which gave a speech at IHRC on the occasion of sixtieth anniversary of Universal Human Rights Declaration (December, 2008). They then submitted the edited form of their speech and some of them submitted an independent article. This book of more than

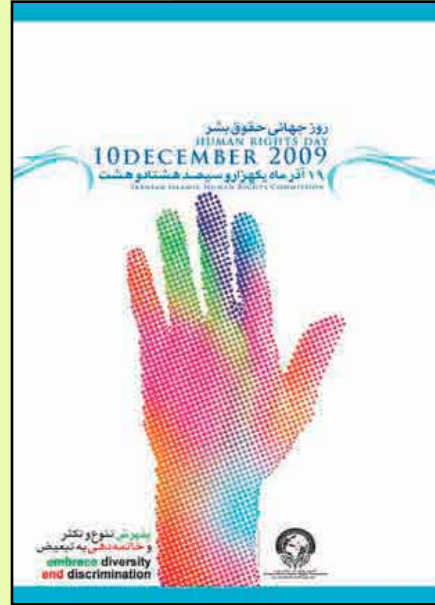


500 pages is consisted of ten separate parts with each part containing one or more article about Universal Declaration of Human Rights. The Foreword of the book written by IHRC Secretary, in four separate paragraphs and 37 pages, presents some points about concrete manifestation of observing human rights, methodology of human rights study in Iran and its provisional aspects, and some recommendations for research and executive centers.

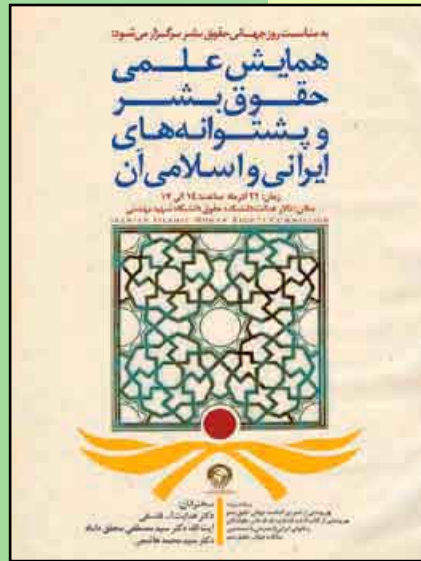
Arts and Human Rights

In the past few weeks, IHRC members of Art and Human Rights Working Group rendered different artistic works which were used on their special occasions or are ready to be used. These are as follows:

- Artistic designing of call for cooperation of students and professors of art faculties with IHRC Art and Human Rights Working Group.



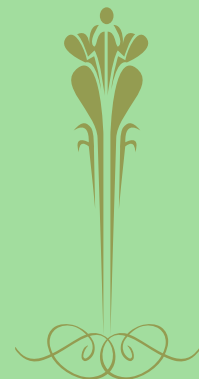

- Designing artistic cover, post card and postal envelop for universal honoring of Human Rights to be used by post office in Iran and abroad after the unveiling of the stamp.

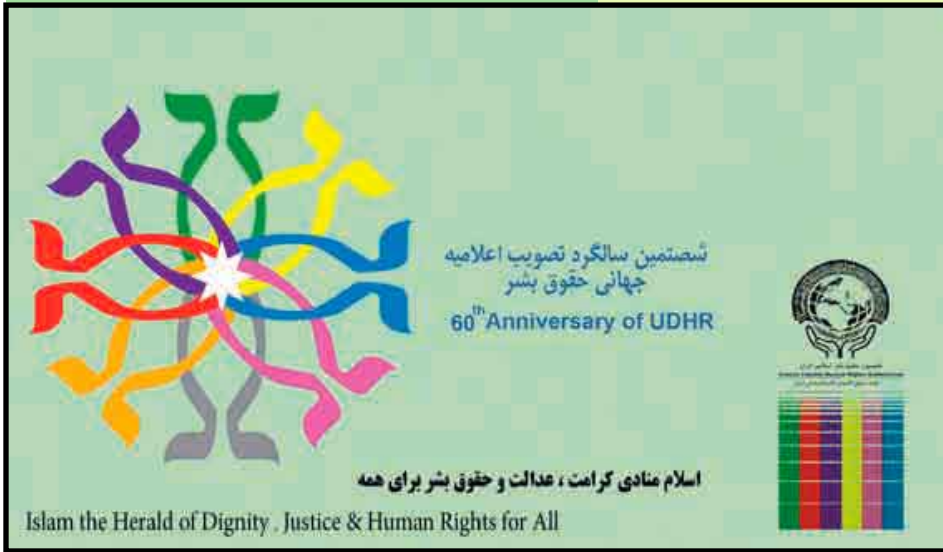

Regional Offices

During past few weeks, the Central Office carried out numerous programs to help provincial offices make the best use of their local potential to advance human rights. Each and every Office had a number of programs carried out according to its potential and facilities, the most significant of which follows (the details of these activities are available in the IHRC website in Persian. Gatherings and meetings by the provincial offices have already been mentioned in this report):

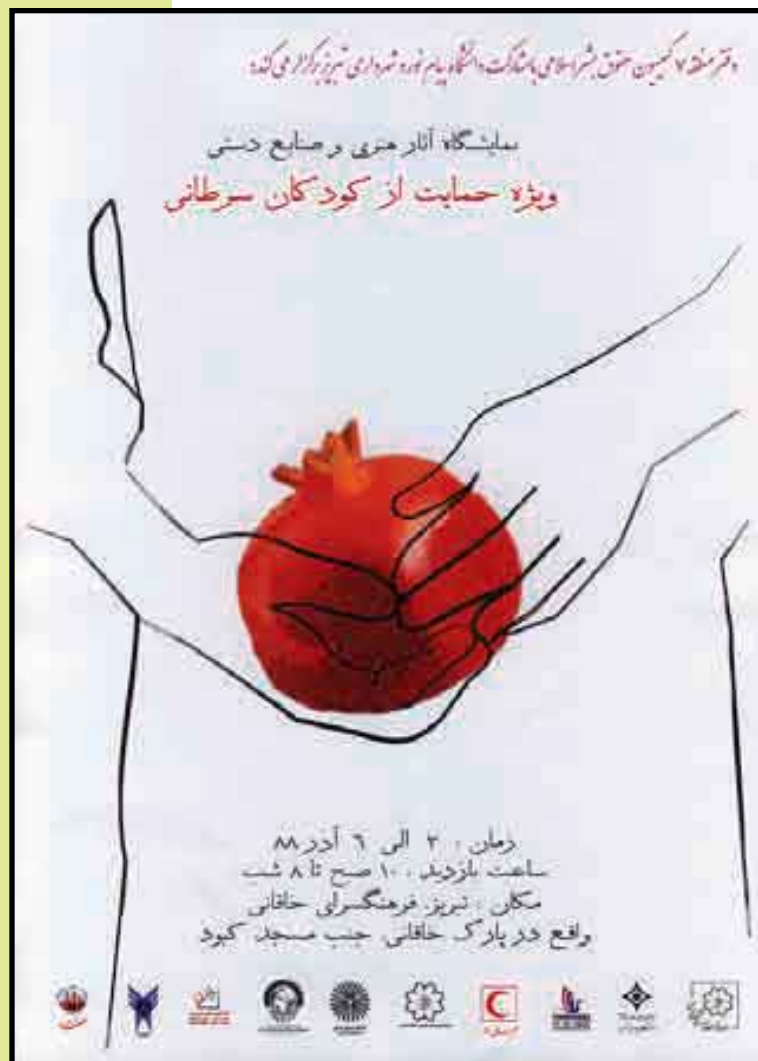


- Office No.7 had variety of activities including: holding several expert working groups of IHRC honorary members in the domains of media and freedom of expression, people with disabilities' rights, women's rights; holding a meeting on the occasion of International Day of Prevention of Torture against Women in the province office; visiting the Children and Adolescents Intellectual Development Center and agreeing on cooperation for improving children's rights; visiting of the general secretary of Tazirat organization from office No.7; issuing general statement of popular cooperators about the destruction of some of the Cultural-Religious works in Azarbaijan Republic; regular updating of Bashar News website and weblog of Office No.7 which, besides the mentioned events, had covered

the photos of gatherings in the Office during the month. Office No.7 in Oct.30 also had cooperated with Labour House of Eastern Azarbaijan in holding scientific meeting titled "Entrepreneurism, Business Security and Business Law" and on 24th to 27th of November had participated with other local agencies in holding Handicraft and Art Works Exhibition for absorption of popular support in favor of children suffered from cancer.

- A delegated committee from Tehran into Bushehr investigated the cooperation of Buser officials with each other and with IHRC and after that they decided to transfer Office No.8 center from Bushehr into other province and, like before, Bushehr province continue to work under the cover of Office No.2 in Shiraz province. Of course, the technical system of Office No.8 legal clinic, after the acceptance of Bushehr Press House to be the host of this program and following the joint agreement with this agency, continue to provide legal advice services in Bushehr. It should be noted that following this transfer, in a letter dated 09.12.5 from IHRC Central Office, the chief of justice was informed of this change and he was recommended to have more attempts in fulfilling their responsibility in reviving public rights.

- Office No.6 in Semnan province also had different programs including: holding some of the expert working groups of honorary members of the Office; visiting some of the local centers related to the theme of activities of working groups; absorbing some doctors who provide



free services for needy patients; cooperating with local centers and organizations and trying to expand the Office activities in different cities of Semnan province; holding special program for Universal Day of Human Rights in the Office with presence of active honorary members and provincial board of trustees.

- Office No.2 in Shiraz province, besides the program on the occasion of International Day of Human Rights, had several other activities, including: providing the clients with various legal advices and submitting different complaints received from people to legal affairs of the center; screening film and its evaluation and criticism from the viewpoint of human rights principles; cooperation with medical centers; participating in the volunteers exhibition of the province health center and being appreciated by provincial medical and health officials; holding a meeting with presence of center's active honorary members about 2009 International Day of Human Rights theme; preparing and distributing educational brochure; holding training workshop on the occasion of International Human Rights Day.

- Office No. 3 in Rasht tried a lot in holding training workshop on municipal rights for personnel of Rasht municipality and city council and International Day of Human Rights gathering but due to the lack of coordination between some provincial officials, the mentioned programs did not hold on the proposed schedule and postponed to some other time.

Other Activities

During the past four weeks, the IHRC had other kinds of activities the most important of which are as follows:

- Providing the answer to UNDP questionnaire about evaluating the function of its Office in Iran by International Affairs of IHRC.

- Following the receipt of invitation for scientific gathering titled "The Condition of Citizens' Complaints from Formal Agencies, the Role of National Agencies and Ombudsmen", two interested researchers in this field were introduced to participate in that gathering in England on May 2010 in case they are accepted and undertake the related costs.

- Following the receipt of invitation for training course on national agencies from Office of the UN Human Rights High Commissioner during the past months, in the previous month and before finishing the invitation's deadline, one of the IHRC researchers was introduced as a candidate. Only several persons are to be selected among all candidates of national organizations all over the world.

- Following the receipt of the inquiry by one of the officials in Asia Pacific Human Rights Communication and Data Center about the attitude of Islam's and Iran's constitutional law to human rights, the answer was provided to help him in using related resources.

- On Dec.9, a group of M.A. Human Rights and International Relations students from Mofid University and International Relations faculty of foreign ministry, following the previous preparation of their professor, visited the IHRC and they were informed of various IRHC activities for improving human rights.

- Some delegates from IHRC had attended some of the human rights related scientific gatherings in other centers and organizations and then submitted their written report to IHRC. The events that delegates from Public Relation or Research Affairs of IHRC had participated includes: the gathering related to the opening of new building of the chair for human rights, peace and democracy in Shahid Beheshti University (Dec.15); expert workshop on international evolution of humanitarian law in International Relations faculty with coordination of Red Cross and Red Crescent organization in Iran (Dec.15&16); and the Right to Life gathering which was hold in Legal faculty of Shahid Beheshti University (Dec.8).

- IHRC Library and Documentation Center carried out many attempts to subscribe for or renew the subscription of international human rights journals in 2010.

- New issues of two bulletins on “New Theoretical Evolution of Cultural, Social and Economic Rights” and “New Theoretical Evolution of Human Rights and Islamic Dialogue in Contemporary World” were published and will be distributed in the coming month (month of Day by Iranian calendar).



- On Dec.2&5, one of the IHRC colleagues had a scientific interview with Sedaye Ashena Radio (one of the Iranian radio networks) on the occasion of International Day of Human Rights which was broadcast on Dec.7.

- 1000 copies of the artistic cover relating to Universal Anniversary of Human Rights stamp were published by IHRC and given to the Post Office in order to be sent to all national and universal collectors of stamp. Some of these covers together with the stamp were also sent for country officials or related centers.

- Required preparations for delegation of some professors to the gathering on Family's Rights, which is to be held on Dec.23 in Tabriz, were carried out.

- Required attempts for final preparation of the book on public domain and human rights were carried out in order to be published soon by IHRC.

- Many of the IHRC statements, announcements and activities had public media reflection in the past month. Different parts of IHRC website were regularly updated and the English and Arabic translators also updated the English and Arabic sections of the website.

- 400 packages including 13 types of legal data products were prepared for International Day of Human Rights gathering with coordination of Legal Faculty of Shahid Beheshti University and were distributed among the attendants in the gathering.
